Functional Progress Ratio

A single, objective read of how much recovery has been regained and the direction it is heading. Descriptive, not a forecast. Critical insight to guide clinical decision making.

Clinical Course Decision

The treating team's call on what's next: continue, modify, transition to EP, refer or discharge.

Informed Provider Education

Hallmark of PACT intervention. Targeted RADAR education to improve recognition and decision making of clinicians.

Independent Clinical Review

For a resistant treating team. Collegial, never an audit. Summit, up to 2x. Free to the employer.

Cognitive Coaching A PACT clinician with additional RADAR training to coach workers through psychosocial barriers. Below the psychology threshold.
